★ Spotlight on 2021 Legislative Session

2021

- Advocacy efforts from the NC REALTORS® lobbying team and six NC Council of State members, led by efforts from Treasurer Dale Folwell, resulted in ending the NC eviction moratorium which brought much needed relief for housing providers, who are mom and pop businesses struggling along with their tenants.
- The lobbying team negotiated substantial changes to the HOPE Program in HB110 including allowing landlords to submit a rental assistance application on behalf of the tenant.
- House bill 489 ensures roads intended for the Department of Transportation (DOT) adoption do not end up abandoned, leaving homeowners' safety and financial security in jeopardy.
- No new taxes on RE or RE services.
- Helping to secure \$180 million for Workforce Housing Loan Program through the Housing Finance Agency.

Association Health Care Plans

We led the coalition in 2019 that enacted legislation to allow independent contractors to participate in affordable, quality Association Healthcare Plans.

NC REALTORS® Deemed Essential

In 2020, amidst many COVID restrictions, NC REALTORS® successfully negotiated with Governor Roy Cooper's office to ensure real estate was given an essential services designation.

Protecting Aesthetic Aspects of Residential Properties

In 2015, NC REALTORS® prevented municipalities from establishing regulations to define the aesthetic aspects of residential properties. This would have regulated color, roofing material, location of windows and the overall home layout.

Transfer Taxes

Beginning in 2007, we fought for six years to protect property owners from paying a sales tax when they sell their property. We defeated 24 local transfer tax referenda and then repealed legislation that allowed counties to propose the transfer tax. We also fought off a statewide 1 percent transfer tax in 2013.

While we had many legislative victories throughout the years, the true power and influence of REALTOR® engagement in 2021 led to us successfully advocate the NC Department of Insurance for the ability to provide our members with an affordable healthcare. We saw the culmination of the efforts from 2019 and this work in November 2021 when NC REALTORS® launched the NC REALTORS® Health Benefit Center.
